Travel by public transport

- You can get to The Byre by bus.
- The Byre is in Newbiggin in Bishopdale, a hamlet in the heart of the Yorkshire Dales National Park. Being so rural, there is a limited bus service which stops half a mile away down a hill, so is not suitable. All visitors arrive, and travel around, by car, as there is no real other option. The bus stop is 0.5 miles / 0.8 km from The Byre.
- You can get a taxi with Hello Coopers by calling 01677 424252 or 01609 772295. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

- We have a car park. There are accessible parking spaces. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The path is sloped.
- The route is 1000mm wide, or more.
- We have a car park. There are accessible parking spaces. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.

There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.

From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 3000mm wide, or more.

There is a drop off point immediately outside the gate to The Byre, with designated parking just a few metres away, all within a courtyard setting, which is completely on one level surface - no slopes, steps, thresholds, and well lit by movement sensors - so fully accessible. There is ample room for both unloading and manouvering cars.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1000mm wide, or more.

Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- The door is 900mm wide.
- When you arrive, we can help carry your luggage.
- The main access is at the rear of The Byre, which is fully accessible on the level. At the front of The Byre, there are steps to the upstairs bedroom. These steps are NOT the main access. The upstairs used to be a hay loft so they are still there purely as part of the character and not at all used to gain access to or out of the building. We point this out to our guests on arrival. The stable door at the top of these steps is within the master bedroom & so we guide our guests to use the top part of the stable door as a window only.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

We have high colour contrast between walls and doorframes.

△ Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, bedside lamps, desk or table lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- Non-allergenic bedlinen (duvets, pillows, protectors, sheets, pillowcases) are available on request. Cleaning with 'Ecover' products can be done throughout the cottage prior to arrival, on request.
- We have bed blocks.

- We have a portable hoist.
- No bedrooms have level access. The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 12 steps.
- All bedrooms are ensuite.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- Some showers have a seat.
- Some showers have a handrail.
- The toilets have handrails.
- The walls and the fittings have high colour contrast.
- All bathroom taps in sinks & bath are lever operated. The walls and the bathroom fittings have high colour contrast. The bath is double-ended. There are two sinks in the bathroom. The bathroom has a view over the garden and the Dale beyond.

is Self catering kitchen

The Byre kitchen

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there is level access.
- The route is 900mm wide, or more.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.

Lounge

The Byre lounge

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there is level access. The route is 900mm wide, or more.
- The kitchen / dining area / lounge of The Byre are all open plan in one room, all on the same level.

Getting around outside

The Byre patio

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 1000mm wide, or more. The entrance is 1000mm wide.
- The private patio for guests at The Byre is immediately outside the main entrance to The Byre at the rear of the building. It is totally on the level and has various seating options, along with a parasol and BBQ. The patio overlooks the 3/4 acre garden and the view across the Dale beyond.

Customer care support

Accessibility equipment

- · We provide wheelchairs. Wheelchairs are free.
- We have a hearing loop in A hearing loop is available for use in all our cottages.
- A full list of accessible equipment is shown on our website and also available, on request, in our 'Accessible Luxury' brochure, which lists the equipment and shows the pictures too.

- Assistance dogs are fully supported at our fully accessible cottage - The Dairy. The same support can be provided at The Byre (which is unsuitable for wheelchairs). The nearest toilet area for assistance dogs is located in the courtyard adjacent to the house about 10 metres from the main entrance.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- You can hire mobility equipment from Change Mobility, Harrogate by calling 01423 500666.

Emergency evacuation procedures

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.
- The fire alarm has a vibrating pillow pad.
- The fire alarm has flashing lights.
- There is a 'wake and shake' alarm clock in the bedroom. There is a 'clangy hand bell' that can be used - very loud - to attract attention from people in nearby buildings.

Customer care support

- Some staff have disability awareness training.
- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- The owners live on site and are therefore available almost always, though it is not advertised as a 24 hours service.
